

Regulations on Membership Fees, Review Fees, Publication Fees, and Conference Registration Fees

(Adopted at the Executive Board Meeting on February 19, 2026, and subject to subsequent approval by the General Assembly. Effective March 1, 2026.)

1. The annual membership fees shall be as follows:

- Full-time Faculty Members: KRW 40,000
- Part-time Faculty Members and Graduate Students: KRW 30,000
- Institutional Members: KRW 130,000

2. The lifetime membership fee shall be KRW 300,000. Members who have paid the lifetime membership fee (including Honorary Members) shall be exempt from annual membership fees and conference registration fees.

3. Payment of the annual membership fee is required for submission of manuscripts to Interpretation and Translation. For co-authored manuscripts, each author must maintain active membership and pay the applicable annual membership fee.

4. The manuscript review fee for submissions to Interpretation and Translation shall be KRW 50,000 per manuscript.

5. The review process shall begin only after confirmation of payment of both the annual membership fee and the manuscript review fee.

6. Upon acceptance of a manuscript for publication, the author(s) shall pay the applicable publication fee.

Publication fees are based on a standard length of up to 25 pages and shall be as follows:

- General Articles: KRW 200,000
- Articles supported by research grants from universities, government agencies, research foundations, or other funding organizations: KRW 300,000

For manuscripts exceeding 25 pages, an additional fee of KRW 10,000 per excess page shall be charged.

7. Publication fees shall be paid promptly following publication of the relevant journal issue. Failure to pay publication fees may result in restrictions or disadvantages regarding future manuscript submissions.

8. Conference registration fees shall be as follows:

Full-time Faculty Members: KRW 35,000 (Early Registration: KRW 25,000)

Lecturers / General Participants: KRW 25,000 (Early Registration: KRW 15,000)

Graduate Students: KRW 20,000 (Early Registration: KRW 10,000)

9. The Treasurer shall be responsible for the collection and management of membership fees, review fees, publication fees, conference registration fees, and the issuance of payment certificates or receipts. Where necessary, matters relating to fee administration may be determined in consultation with the officers of the Society.
